Dear Parent / Guardian

As you are aware, the Welsh Government are transforming expectations, experiences and outcomes for children and young people with Additional Learning Needs (ALN), and we refer you to the Additional Learning Needs and Education Tribunal (Wales) Act 2018 (the Act). The new legislation and system will improve the planning and delivery of support for learners from 0 to 25, placing learners' needs, views and wishes at the heart of the process. Your child, from the date of this letter, will move to the new ALN system.

Following consideration of the progress of your child, I am writing to advise you that after taking into account advice and information from relevant professionals, it has been determined that your child does not have an ALN within the meaning of the Act. The reason for this, is that your child does not have an ALN which calls for an Additional Learning Provision (ALP). As a result, an Individual Development Plan (IDP) will not be issued for your child.

Please rest assured that your child will receive the support they need in the classroom via reasonable adjustments and high-quality differentiated learning. Through careful planning, assessment and identification of next steps, your child's teacher/s will continue to meet their needs. Your child's needs will also be monitored in case they change.

Other strategies to support your child may include;
