School Dinner Money Just a quick reminder that school dinners are now £2.00 per day. Please send all dinner money to school on Monday morning. Many thanks.

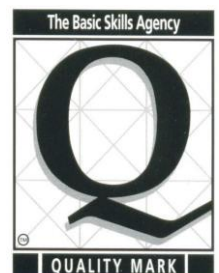
