Concerts

Covid

Another reminder that Covid numbers are increasing again, and we have seen a significant rise in numbers in both staff and pupils. Many thanks to all parents who have informed us when children are poorly with Covid. Again, may I remind you that we are still expected to ensure that classrooms are well ventilated, and therefore at times during the day, we will be popping open windows to 'air' classrooms. If you could please consider this in the mornings I would be very grateful, and if the weather takes a turn it will be important that children are dressed warmly for school, so they aren't cold when rooms are ventilated. Many thanks.

If a pupil tests positive for Covid, then they will need to isolate for 5 days from the day of the test OR the day the symptoms started. In this circumstance, if you could contact the school we would be very grateful, this will allow us to be extra vigilant with all of the other children in the class, and if necessary keep parents fully informed.

Attendance

Given that we know that Covid is still prevalent in our community, we are very mindful that your child's attendance may have already been impacted by a Covid absence. With that in mind it is really important that you contact us to explain any absences, so that we can be fully aware of any extenuating circumstances, which may have affected your child's attendance to date. Mr Bills, our attendance officer, is currently analysing our attendance data and is preparing letters for all children. This will keep you fully informed of your child's attendance to date. As usual we are always keen to work with families to support you to improve your child's attendance. Should you need support, please ask to speak to Mr Bills, and he will contact you when he is able. Rags to Riches Collection

We have arranged a collection with Rags to Riches. If you have any good quality clothes that you could donate, we will collect up to the **morning of the 25th November.** You can bring donations into school and pass them on to staff on the doors in the mornings. For every Kilogram of clothes we collect, we get 40p. The clothes are then re-used in a number of environmentally friendly ways.
